1. Request for Clarification

A respondent asked the following questions:

- A. On page 4 of the statement of qualifications it says in the ranking criteria that the Construction Price is 35% of the score, usually in CMARS we do not provide any pricing in the first phase can you please clarify this?
- B. Is this a CMAR or a CSP since you are asking for pricing?
- C. Is this a two-step process as in first is requesting qualifications then second is taking actual pricing and proposal numbers?

2. Response

- A. This is a one step CMAR process as authorized by <u>TEX. GOVERNMENT CODE</u> Section 2269.253. Qualifications and fees/prices are both considered in one step. This is not a Request for Qualifications (RFQ), as would be with a two step process.
- B. This is a Construction Manager At-Risk (CMAR) procurement process.
- C. This is a one step CMAR process.
